Be licensed and ordained in accordance with **Baptist church principles**

Hold at least a **Bachelor's degree** (in Business, Theology, or related field); a **Master of Divinity, Theology, or comparable degree** from an accredited theological seminary is preferred

Have a minimum of **10 years of pastoral or ministerial leadership** experience in a Baptist context

Proven administrative, strategic planning, and team management skills

Strong written and verbal communication abilities

Technologically proficient and open to modern tools for ministry

Visionary leadership, with a heart for **youth, young adults, and church growth**

Demonstrated ability to **counsel**, resolve conflict, and unify a diverse congregation

Experience in developing **Christian education programs, leadership pipelines, and community outreach** initiatives

PASTORAL RESPONSIBILITIES

Conduct weddings, funerals, baptisms, and visitations (sick/shut-in)

Shepherd all members with compassion, promoting unity and reconciliation
